**1.** The meeting was opened at 8.35pm.

**2. Apologies.** There were apologies from Parish Councillors Alan Rowbotham and Andrew Pett, County Councillor Julie Wisson and District Councillors Barbara Boddington and Richard West.

**3. Declarations of Interest.** There were no declarations of interest.

**4. Planning. 1. 17/00653/FUL Construction of a B1-office and extension to existing car park Gransden Park Potton Road.** No objections had been received from neighbours. Jeff Gorton proposed ‘**Approval**’ on the ground it is a satisfactory addition to an existing commercial site. Seconded by Stephanie Beaumont and carried unanimously.

**2. 17/00670/FUL Erection of an Agricultural Machinery Shed North Farm Potton Road.** Michael Capps explained the site lay-out. Ian Selkirk recommended ‘**Approval**’ on the ground that it is a reasonable development of an existing agricultural site and required for an extended farm area. Seconded by Debi Pearce and carried unanimously.

**5. Housing White Paper Consultation.** The chairman commented that the white paper was a 111 page document with insufficient time allowed before the consultation closed for comment. Whilst Nalc had provided a response form, councillors considered that any comment would merely be paying lip service. Councillors agreed to leave the matter on the table.
